A software approach that prioritizes storing and processing data directly on your device without being connected to the internet.

context

Background information or the whole of previous conversations provided to artificial intelligence in order for it to understand a topic correctly.

prefix-cache

An acceleration method that prevents the repeated processing of long commands given to artificial intelligence by keeping the initial parts in memory.

agentic skills framework

A software framework that organizes the capabilities that artificial intelligence needs to perform complex tasks.

inference

The process of a trained artificial intelligence model making a prediction or answer using new data.

taste

The ability to distinguish the aesthetic and functional quality of a technological product or design.

generative AI

Artificial intelligence technology that can create new content such as text, visuals or audio based on the data it learns.

text generation

The computer writes meaningful and natural sentences according to a given command.

multimodal

A system that can simultaneously process not only text but also different types of data such as images, audio and video.

multimodal large language model

An advanced artificial intelligence model that can understand and process different types of data, such as images and audio, as well as text.

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
