The set of capabilities that artificial intelligence needs to make decisions and take action on its own.

graph-native infrastructure

A special data storage structure that maintains direct connections between data.

LLM

Advanced artificial intelligence that can speak and write like a human by examining huge texts on the Internet.

swarm intelligence

Many simple units come together and act as a single intelligent system.

API

A bridge that allows two different software to talk to each other and share data.

environment variables

Small identifiers that hold settings and confidential information that programs need while running.

task runner

Utility tool that automatically runs repetitive software jobs sequentially.

autonomous AI agents

Artificial intelligences that make and implement their own decisions in line with their goals without human intervention.

core libraries

Ready-made code packages required for a software to perform its basic functions.

caching

The process of temporarily storing frequently used data in memory for quick access.

AI agents

Software designed to perform specific tasks and capable of making intelligent decisions.

self-hosted

Hosting a service on your own computer or server rather than on someone else's server.

durable objects

Small pieces of software that run continuously on the Internet and can store data without losing its state.

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
