core libraries

Ready-made code packages that enable a software to perform its basic functions.

caching

The process of temporarily storing frequently used data in memory for quick access.

self-hosted

The situation of running a service on a personal computer that you control, rather than on someone else's server.

durable objects

Small pieces of software that can run continuously and maintain their state on the Internet without losing data.

cloud computing

Provision of services such as computer power and storage via remote servers over the Internet.

CI/CD

System that allows software updates to be tested and released automatically.

GDPR

A set of legal rules that determine how the personal data of Internet users will be protected.

data residency

The obligation to keep digital data within the borders of a certain geographical region or country for legal reasons.

generative AI

Artificial intelligence technology that can create new images, text or sounds using existing data.

home server

A personal computer that is kept on at all times to perform tasks such as file sharing or media management of home devices.

text generation

Artificial intelligence creates meaningful sentences and texts according to the commands given.
