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**AI code editor**

A smart editing tool that finds errors while writing software and offers code suggestions for you.

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**CLI**

Text-based interface that runs programs with written commands rather than the mouse.

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**long-term memory**

Artificial intelligence can remember past conversations or information for a long time and use it in new transactions.

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**generative AI**

Technology that produces new content such as text, visuals or audio from scratch using the data it learns.

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**runtime**

The moment when a software is run and activated on the computer.

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**multi-agent**

The work of multiple AI units that collaborate with each other and share complex tasks.

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**observability**

The process of understanding where and why errors occur by monitoring the functioning within a system.

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**RAG**

Artificial intelligence produces answers by pulling up-to-date data from reliable external sources without its own knowledge.

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**context database**

It is a place where the information needed by artificial intelligence to provide more accurate answers is kept regularly.

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**prompt**

The instruction or question you give to the AI to get a result from it.

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**token**

The smallest piece of data corresponding to words or syllables that artificial intelligence uses when processing texts.

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**red teaming**

An attempt to find vulnerabilities by pretending to be a malicious user to test the security of a system.

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
