skills

agentic skills framework

The structure that organizes the abilities that artificial intelligence needs to make decisions and take action on its own.

plugins

Small utilities that are added to a software and add new features to it.

specification

A set of detailed technical rules that specify how a product or software should work.

CLI

Text-based interface that allows you to manage programs by entering written commands rather than using a mouse.

long-term memory

Artificial intelligence can store past information for a long time without forgetting it and use it when needed.

large language models

Artificial intelligence models trained with huge data that can understand human language and produce text.

runtime

The moment a software is run on a computer and the environment it needs in this process.

framework

A basic system that makes things easier when developing software and offers ready-made codes and structures.

multi-agent

Multiple artificial intelligence units communicate with each other for a common goal.

observability

The ability to understand what is going on by monitoring the internal workings and errors of a software from the outside.

context database

A private data warehouse where the information needed by artificial intelligence to respond better is kept.

RAG

It is a method in which artificial intelligence produces more accurate answers by reading external documents without its own knowledge.

token

The smallest piece of data corresponding to words or syllables that artificial intelligence uses when processing texts.

red teaming

An attempt to find vulnerabilities by pretending to be a malicious user to test the security of a system.

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
