Autonomous software that can make decisions on its own and use tools to achieve goals.

skills

Special capabilities or functions that AI models use to perform specific tasks.

local-first

A software approach where data is stored and processed directly on your device without the need for the Internet.

AI observability

The process of monitoring and analyzing how artificial intelligence systems work and why they make certain decisions.

static type checking

An automatic checking mechanism that detects data errors in the code before it is run.

agentic skills framework

The infrastructure that organizes and manages the capabilities that artificial intelligence needs to perform complex tasks.

CLI

Text-based interface that allows you to manage programs by entering written commands rather than using a mouse.

plugins

Small, independent plug-in files used to add new features to the main software.

CMS

A system that allows you to create websites and easily manage your content without knowing coding.

multi-player swarms

Artificial intelligence groups that communicate with each other and collaborate towards a common goal.

RAG

It is a method in which artificial intelligence scans data from external sources and adds it to its answers in order to obtain up-to-date information.

binary

A machine language file consisting only of zeros and ones that the computer can directly understand and execute.

inference

The phase of a trained artificial intelligence model making predictions or producing results with the new data it receives.

paywall

A digital barrier that requires payment of a fee to access content on the Internet.

digital privacy

Your right to control who can view your personal information on the Internet.

large language models

Artificial intelligence models trained with huge data that can understand human language and produce text.

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
