skills

agentic skills framework

A set of structural capabilities that enable artificial intelligence systems to make decisions on their own and carry out complex tasks.

DPI

The number of dots per inch that determines the image quality of a display or printer.

LLM

Advanced artificial intelligence models trained to learn human language and transcribe, summarize or translate text.

SaaS

A service model that allows you to use the software directly with a subscription over the internet instead of installing it on your computer.

PaaS

Providing ready-made infrastructure over the internet for software developers to develop and publish their own applications.

IaaS

Using basic hardware resources such as server, storage and network for rent over the internet.

static typing

Determining and checking the type of data in a programming language before the code is executed.

plugins

Small utilities that add new features to a main program.

specification

A detailed list of technical rules and requirements that specify how a software or product should work.

AI observability

The process of monitoring how artificial intelligence systems work and tracking their errors and behavior.

red teaming

The attempt to find vulnerabilities by pretending to be a malicious attacker to test the security of a system.

large language models

Artificial intelligence models trained with huge data that can understand human language and produce text.

Language Server Protocol

A standard communication method that enables coded tools to work compatible with different programming languages.

web scraping

The process of copying and collecting data from websites using automated tools.

generative AI

Artificial intelligence technology that can produce new content such as text, visuals or audio using existing data.

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
