generative AI

Artificial intelligence technology that can generate new content such as text, images, or audio using existing data.

ad blocker

A browser extension that prevents unwanted advertisements on websites from loading.

multimodal AI

Artificial intelligence that can process not only text but also different data types like images and audio simultaneously.

multimodal model

An artificial intelligence structure capable of analyzing and processing different types of information such as text, images, and audio together.

text generation

The process of an artificial intelligence creating logical and meaningful sentences about a given topic.

multimodal

The ability to perceive multiple data types, such as text and images, at the same time.

GGUF

A file format that allows large artificial intelligence models to run faster and more efficiently on personal computers.

recursive reproduction number

The growth rate ratio that occurs during an artificial intelligence system's self-replication and improvement process.

looped transformer

An artificial intelligence architecture that consumes less memory by using the same processing layers repeatedly.

mixture-of-experts

A system that uses small sub-models, each specialized in a different subject, together to solve complex tasks.
