AI agents

Autonomous software that can make its own decisions and perform specific tasks on your behalf.

skills

The set of capabilities a piece of software or artificial intelligence possesses to perform a specific job.

skill

A specialized skill that a system uses to perform a specific task.

token

The smallest unit of data that artificial intelligence uses when processing text, corresponding to words or fragments of syllables.

generative AI

Technology that can create new text, images, or sounds based on information it has previously learned.

foundation model

A foundational artificial intelligence structure trained on very large datasets, upon which many different applications can be developed.

proxy

An intermediary server that manages the connection between you and the internet, routing traffic while masking your identity.

inference server

A computer system that runs a trained artificial intelligence model to generate instant answers to incoming questions.

framework

A fundamental building block that simplifies tasks during software development by providing ready-made tools and rules.

prompts

The written instructions or questions you provide to an artificial intelligence to obtain a result.

agentic skills framework

The software infrastructure that organizes the capabilities artificial intelligences need to perform complex tasks.

top-level domain

The extension at the very end of internet addresses that indicates the type or country of the site.

artificial general intelligence

A hypothetical level of artificial intelligence that possesses human-level intelligence and is capable of performing any intellectual task.

electric propulsion systems

Motor systems that use electrical energy instead of fuel to move vehicles.

text generation

The computer's ability to generate content by forming meaningful and coherent sentences according to the given commands.

multimodal model

Artificial intelligence that can understand and process not only text but also different data types such as images and audio simultaneously.

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
