As the vulnerability is being actively exploited, users are advised to update their browsers to the latest version.

skills

The specific capabilities an AI model acquires to perform a particular task.

syntax

The set of spelling and punctuation rules that must be followed when writing code in a programming language.

generative AI

AI technology capable of generating new content such as text, images, or audio using previously learned data.

token

The smallest unit of data that corresponds to words or parts of syllables used by AI when processing text.

inference server

A powerful computer system that runs a trained AI model to generate responses to incoming queries.

PoC

A small-scale preliminary trial conducted to see if a new idea or technology is viable.

foundation model

A foundational AI structure trained on very large datasets upon which different tasks can be built.

LLM

An advanced AI system with the ability to understand, interpret, and generate human language in a natural way.

VLM

An AI model capable of analyzing and commenting on both text and images simultaneously.

reinforcement learning

A training method where AI is rewarded for correct decisions and penalized for incorrect ones.

post-training

An additional refinement process performed on a model that has completed its basic training to make it more specialized in a specific subject.

coding agent

An autonomous system capable of writing software code, fixing errors, and developing projects based on instructions received from the user.

HDR

A technology that offers more realistic colors by increasing the difference between the brightest and darkest points in images.

HLSL

A special programming language used to calculate lighting and shadow effects in games and graphics applications.

Mermaid

A simple tool that allows you to quickly create flowcharts and diagrams by writing lines of code.

SVG

An image file drawn with mathematical formulas, the quality of which does not deteriorate no matter how much the resolution is increased.

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
