The phenomenon where many small units come together to act like a collective intelligence without being managed from a single center.

autonomous hedge fund

A software-based fund that analyzes market data and makes investment decisions on its own without human intervention.

system design

The process of planning how the parts of a software will communicate with each other and how they will function.

plugins

Small utility software used to add new features to the main program.

differential equations

Mathematical formulas used to calculate how variables change in relation to each other.

large language models

Artificial intelligence models trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.
