LLM

Artificial intelligence models trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.

Mixture of Experts

An efficient artificial intelligence architecture that activates only small, specialized sections to solve a complex problem.

code review tool

An inspection tool that automatically reviews code written by developers for errors or improvements.

zero-shot

The ability of artificial intelligence to perform a task it has never seen or been trained on before, directly without any examples.

agentic

The feature of artificial intelligence to plan and take action on its own to reach its goal instead of just waiting for commands.

swarm intelligence

A large number of simple units communicating with each other to cooperate toward a common goal, much like ant colonies.

API

A digital bridge that allows two different software programs to communicate and exchange data with each other.

system prompts

The fundamental instructions that define how an artificial intelligence should behave, what tone it should use, or what rules it should follow.

multi-agent

Multiple artificial intelligences assigned to different tasks working together by assisting each other to complete a complex job.

large language models

Artificial intelligence models trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.

skills

Special skills or toolsets that artificial intelligence uses to perform a specific task.

tokenizer

A system that breaks down texts into small numerical pieces or word groups that artificial intelligence can process.

TTS

Technology that converts written text into a natural human voice via a computer.

ERP

A software system that allows a company to manage all its business processes, such as accounting, inventory, and human resources, from a single center.

CRM

A management system where companies track their relationships with customers, past interactions, and sales processes.

offensive security skills

The ability to perform security tests by thinking like an attacker to find vulnerabilities in systems.

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
