The process of designing and creating computer programs, applications, or websites.

GPU

A specialized hardware unit capable of quickly performing intensive operations, especially image processing and artificial intelligence calculations.

machine learning

A method that enables computers to learn on their own by analyzing data and providing better results over time.

development environments

A workspace where developers write and test their code and find all the tools they need in one place.

generative UI

Screen designs generated instantly by artificial intelligence according to the user's current needs.

engineering skills

The ability to solve complex problems with logical steps and build systems.

weights

Numerical values that determine how artificial intelligence evaluates the information it has learned.

orchestrator

A central system that manages the compatible operation of different software components or artificial intelligence tools.

agents

Software that can observe its environment and make independent decisions to perform a specific task.

high bandwidth memory

High-performance specialized memory technology that enables data to be transferred to the processor very quickly.

digital preservation

The process of storing and protecting digital files and information for many years without corruption.
