Similar ones where the source codes of a popular software are copied and offered free of charge so that anyone can modify them.

tech stack

All of the programming languages, databases and tools used when developing a website or mobile application.

playlist

A list of music or videos sorted by users according to their tastes on digital platforms.

API

A digital bridge that allows two different software to talk to each other and exchange data.

web scraping

The process of copying and transferring data from websites to another place using automatic software.
