It combines features such as multi-tenancy, single sign-on (SSO) and role-based access control (RBAC) in a structure developed with TypeScript.

The thirty-year prison sentence of Daniel Sanchez Estrada for distribution of a magazine (zine) triggers legal debates within the scope of free speech. This decision risks setting a precedent for digital and print content sharing, as broadcast distribution activities face criminal sanctions.

multi-tenancy

A single software serving many different users or companies independently of each other at the same time.

SSO

Ease of logging into multiple different applications with a single username and password.
