Developed by PrismML, Bonsai 27B was designed as a large language model with 27 billion parameters that can run on smartphones. The model makes models that require high computational power accessible on mobile devices by using model compression techniques.

03 How to stop Claude from saying load-bearing

The expression "load-bearing", which large language models (LLM) like Claude often use in their answers, is a pattern that indicates that the model has excessive reliance on a particular context. Users can prevent such repetitive expressions that reduce content quality through system prompts and enable the model to produce more original responses.
