CLI

Text-based interface that allows you to manage programs by typing written commands rather than using the mouse.

API

A bridge that allows two different software to talk to each other and exchange data.

code coverage

A measurement value that shows how much of a written program is controlled by tests.

inference engine

A piece of software that produces predictions or conclusions about new data using a trained artificial intelligence model.

prefix-cache

An acceleration method that prevents artificial intelligence from repeating the same operations by keeping the text beginnings it has previously processed in memory.

static site generator

A software tool that takes ready-made content and turns it into fast-loading fixed web pages.

IDE

An advanced working environment that gathers all the tools that software developers need while writing code in one place.

binary

A machine language format consisting only of zeros and ones that the computer can directly understand and execute.

userspace

A safe area where user applications run without touching the operating system kernel of the computer.
