This technique preserves the scene geometry, eliminates unnecessary data, and increases computational efficiency in three-dimensional question-answer processes.

02 DAPD: Dual-Anchored Policy Distillation

Dual-anchored policy distillation aims to eliminate the information asymmetry between teacher and student models in the training process of language models. This method increases model performance by preventing the student from developing erroneous behaviors based on privileged data that he cannot access during the inference phase.

04 DiffusionGemma Technical Report

Developed by Google, DiffusionGemma performs parallel processing in blocks of 256 using discrete diffusion, unlike traditional methods in text production. This approach aims to generate text at high speed by overcoming the sequential word generation bottleneck in large language models.

CADENA is a system that converts three-dimensional mesh models (3D mesh) into parametric computer-aided design (CAD) programs. By mimicking the way human engineers work, it builds the model step by step, adding features and performing geometric verifications at each stage, rather than building it all at once.
