VPS

Renting and using a server on the Internet as if it were your own private computer.

fine-tuning

The process of retraining a general-purpose trained artificial intelligence with a small data set to become more expert on a specific subject.

production pipeline

The automated series of stages that software goes through after it is developed and tested until it is released to real users.
