A set of rules established by Google used to ensure that code written in the Java language is organized and readable.

Sun Code Conventions

A series of standards created by the company that developed the Java language, recommended to be followed when writing code.

OSINT

A method of collecting and analyzing information from publicly available sources on the internet.

SEO

Improvement efforts made for websites to appear higher in search engine rankings.

LLM

Artificial intelligence systems trained on massive amounts of text data that can converse like a human.

patent disclosure

The disclosure of all details of an invention to the public or the relevant institution so that it can be legally protected.

reinforcement learning

The process of artificial intelligence learning to make correct decisions through trial and error and using a reward mechanism.

web crawlers

Software bots that automatically browse pages on the internet and record data.

prompt engineering

The art of optimizing the prompts given to artificial intelligence to get the best and most accurate results from it.

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
