local-first

A software approach that relies on data being stored directly on your device without needing the internet and being able to work while offline.

voice-to-text

Technology that listens to your spoken words in real-time and converts them into written text.

LLM

Artificial intelligence models trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.

swarm intelligence

A collective working method where many small and simple units come together to solve complex problems.
