A technical method that enables artificial intelligence to provide longer and more consistent answers by efficiently using the amount of information it can remember at one time.

Model Context Protocol

A standard communication method that allows artificial intelligence models to easily connect to different data sources and tools to retrieve information.

stealth headless browser

A specialized browser software that can browse in the background secretly without being detected as a robot by websites.

CRO

Efforts to increase the rate at which visitors to a website perform desired actions, such as making a purchase or signing up.

SuperAgent

Advanced artificial intelligence software capable of making its own decisions and planning and executing complex tasks.

sandbox

An isolated workspace created to safely test new software without harming your computer.

skills

Special skills or task definitions acquired by artificial intelligence models to perform a specific job.

headless browser

A browser that does not have a visual interface and only loads web pages and collects data via code in the background.

RAG

The process of artificial intelligence not being content with what it already knows and generating more accurate answers by pulling information from current documents or databases.

telemetry

Usage data automatically collected from a system to understand how software is used and where errors originate.

open-weight

Artificial intelligence models whose internal structure and parameters are shared with everyone so that developers can run them on their own systems.

frontier AI

Artificial intelligence systems with the most advanced capabilities that push the boundaries of current technology.

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
