Artificial intelligence models trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.

runtime

The period during which a computer program is actively running on a user's computer after it has been launched.

AI agents

Autonomous AI software capable of making its own decisions and performing specific tasks.

CLI

A text-based interface that allows you to manage programs by entering written commands instead of using a mouse.

agent tools

Software components that enable artificial intelligence to interact with the outside world or perform transactions on the internet.

routing layer

A digital routing layer that manages traffic to ensure incoming data or requests reach the correct destination.

large language model

An artificial intelligence model trained on massive amounts of data that can understand human language and generate text.

reasoning capabilities

The ability of an artificial intelligence to solve complex problems by reasoning and thinking step-by-step.

persistent ads

Advertisements that constantly appear while browsing web pages or remain fixed in a corner of the screen.

generative AI

Artificial intelligence technology capable of creating content such as text, images, or audio from scratch that did not exist before.

artificial intelligence

The process of computers gaining the ability to learn, make decisions, and solve problems like humans.
